The exhibit explores the human relationship with food through the perspectives of over thirty-four local, national and international artists. Guests wishing to participate in the food fight should wear all white attire (something they don't mind getting messy!) that will become a wearable canvas during the food fight. A recipe card will also be given to guests when they enter the Loudoun House for the evening, and when their card is called, they will have the opportunity to participate in Food Fight. Once guests have participated, they can visit the cleaning station if they wish to re-enter the Loudoun House gallery.

"Within the context of all of our exhibitions we encourage our guests to explore their relationship with the content they see. For this event we are encouraging our guests to have some fun and connect to the exhibition "food fight" content through an interactive experience," says Stephanie Harris, LAL's Executive Director.

This event will be a great time for the whole family: Creative Alliance will be providing some fun art activities for the kids. The band Idiot Glee will be performing indie pop music live throughout the evening, and local chefs will also be onsite preparing delicious food for purchase, including Craig DeVilliers of Graze Market & Cafe and Dan Wu of Culinary Evangelist.

As usual, keeping the arts accessible to all community members is of the utmost importance to LAL. Thus, this event is offered at an admission cost of just \$5, with \$15 being the suggested "Generous Admission" price point.
