Fourth Fridays Return in Celebration of LAL's new exhibit, *FEAST: Pleasure + Hunger + Ritual*

The event series is brought back by popular demand and reinstitutes a beloved community arts event to a broader public through partnerships with CRAVE Lexington and other organizations.
