The Woodland Art Fair is celebrating its 45th Anniversary this **August 15th-16th**. The Lexington Art League and Parks and Recreation have the pleasure to offer local non-profits a free community engagement space for children and families during the fair. We would like to continue this partnership with the community by further developing the community engagement space. To do so, we are extending this application to organizations to create simple proposals for family friendly creative activities.

Non-profit organizations are encouraged to submit proposals for 2 - 3 hour blocks of time during the hours of the fair, 10am - 6pm.

As always, the Kids Zone will be in the Pavilion next to the playground. This is a covered space with cement floor and access to picnic tables with attached benches. Depending on demand, the Pavilion may split into two sections for up to two organizations to use simultaneously.

Guidelines/ Expectations:

- Lexington Art League provides a parking pass to the fair (parking is located on the baseball field) Lexington Art League may be able provide help moving materials via golf cart as needed and as available. Please arrive early as parking does become full.
- Lexington Art League provides security for the fair on Friday and Saturday night, but the Lexington Art League is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- Please consider that the typical audience for the community engagement space varies from toddlers to middle school aged children and even adults.
- Provide an activity that can be setup and cleaned up in 15 minutes.
- Your organization is responsible for providing all supplies for activities.
- Your organization is permitted to provide marketing materials, but **no sales of any kind are allowed at the art fair.**

- Since the Lexington Art League offers this free opportunity to community organizations, if selected to participate, organizations are asked to not participate in the fair across the street.
 - Availability is limited, first come first serve.
 - Please note your preference for time/date. A final schedule will be constructed to best suit all requests. Your preference may or may not be realized in the final schedule.
 - Final schedules will be announced no later than three weeks before the WAF.
- Applications due by June 15th, 2020.
